

Young Haymakers Fees – From September 2025- March 2026

(Please note these are subject to review in December, March and September each year)

2 year olds – Non funded rate £10.50 per hour 2-year-old

(applies up to the term after their 3rd birthday)

With Extended Working Families Offer

Families can access 5 hours funded per day 11-4pm

Families who are eligible for the 30 hours working families offer can access a maximum 25 hours per week

Any additional hours each day are charged at the non-funded rate as stated above.

For parent/carers who wish for EYEE hours only this is offered between

11am - 4pm during term time, 38-week period.

Mid -morning and Afternoon snack can be purchased @£2.50 per snack plus enrichment activities as stated below.

2-Year-Old Children Who Receive Additional Forms of Support:

Children aged 2 years receiving additional forms of support are eligible for up to 15 hours of funding per week. This is also known as 'Disadvantaged two-year-old funding'. We support families receiving this type of funding ~ please speak to nursery manager for more details.

The options below are for parents/carers who require extended hours over and above the funded hours and wish to purchase the additional all-inclusive services we offer which go far beyond the EYFS basic requirements for government funded childcare. However, they are an option and NOT intended as a barrier to parents who wish to enrol their child at Young Haymakers for only funded hours.

Please be aware that this is subject to availability

OPTION 1 – Inclusive Package

A child attends 9.00 - 4.00 each day = 7 hours

5 hours each day are fully funded = £0.00

2 hours non funded private fees @£10.50 = £21.00

Food, enrichment and activities =£11.00 (see below)

School day = £32.00 per day

OPTION 2 – Inclusive Package

A child attends from 8.30 - 4.30 each day = 8 hours

5 hours each day are fully funded =£0.00

3 hours non funded private fees @£10.50 = £31.50

Food, enrichment and activities = £11.00 (see below)

Full day session = £42.50 per day

OPTION 3 – Inclusive Package

A child attends from 8.00 - 5.00 each day = 9 hours

5 hours each day are fully funded = £0.00

4 hours non funded private fees @£10.50 = £42.00

Food, enrichment and activities = £11.00

Extended day session = £53.00 a day

N.B: Lunch: Packed lunch provided by parents/carers

Food: Delicious snacks am and pm from our healthy eating snack menu, prepared fresh daily, including products from our growing garden and orchard = £5.00 (two snacks)

Enrichment and activities as below = £6.00

Please note you are responsible for rechecking and reconfirming your eligibility every **3 months and you **MUST** inform the nursery if your circumstances change.**

Full fees are payable should your eligibility change, and the nursery is unable to claim funding on your behalf.

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3 and 4 year olds - Non funded rate £12.00 per hour – 3 years old+

(applies from the term after a child is 3)

3-year-olds in the term after their third birthday – all children eligible for the Universal 15 hours Early Years Education Entitlement (EYEE)

With Universal 15 EYEE funded hours families can access 5 funded hours per day 11-4pm

Some children will be able to access an additional 15 hours, subject to parents' eligibility (30 hours total)

However, we can only offer a maximum of 25 hours per week.

5 hours funded per day 11-4pm-Up to 5 times a week

This depends on parents eligibility

Mid-morning and Afternoon snack can be purchased @£2.50 per snack plus enrichment activities, see below.

N.B. Not all enrichment activities listed are delivered within the funded hours, please speak with nursery manager for more clarity.

The options below are for parents/carers who require extended hours over and above the funded hours and wish to purchase the additional all-inclusive services we offer which go far beyond the EYFS basic requirements for government funded childcare. School day session = £40.50 per day

OPTION 2 – Inclusive Package

A child attends from 8.30 - 4.30 each day = 8 hours

5 hours each day are fully funded = £0.00

3 hours non funded private hours @£12.00 = £36.00

Food, enrichment and activities= £16.50 (see below)

Full day session = £52.50 per day

OPTION 3- Inclusive Package

A child attends from 8.00 - 5.00 each day = 9 hours

5 hours each day are fully funded = £0.00

4 hours non funded private hours @£12.00 =£48.00

Food, enrichment and activities =£16.50 (see below)

Extended day session = £64.50 a day

N.B: Lunch: Packed lunch provided by parents/carers

The enrichment and activities above far exceed the effective delivery of the Early Years Foundation Stage (EYFS) statutory framework as set out with the DfE Guidance April 2025.

A child born on or between	Will be eligible to EYEE funding from
1 st April and 31 st August	Start of term 1, in September, following their 3 rd birthday
1 st September and 31 st December	Start of term 3, in January, following their 3 rd birthday
1 st January and 31 st March	Start of term 5, in April, following their 3 rd birthday

For parent/carers who chose EYEE funded only hours this is offered between 11-4pm term time. It is your choice as parent/carers to send your child to us and if you decide not to take any of the three options, as stated above, unfortunately we are unable to provide our forest school and other extensive enrichment activities without a charge.

Your child will be able to enjoy many aspects of our amazing high-quality environments and be guided and nurtured by our unique staff team, meeting the EYFS statutory requirements as set out by the DfE, November 2024 and further guidance in April 2025.

Illness/absence:

Fees are still payable in the event of a child's absence due to illness, holiday, adverse weather conditions and other reasons. Please see terms and conditions for more information.

Parents/carers must notify the nursery if their child will be absent

Notice period:

Parents/ carers are required to provide a minimum of a term's notice (depending on time of year this could be 7 weeks) when moving their child from Young Haymakers Nursery School. Please note, this time frame does not include any school holidays within the term's notice period.
